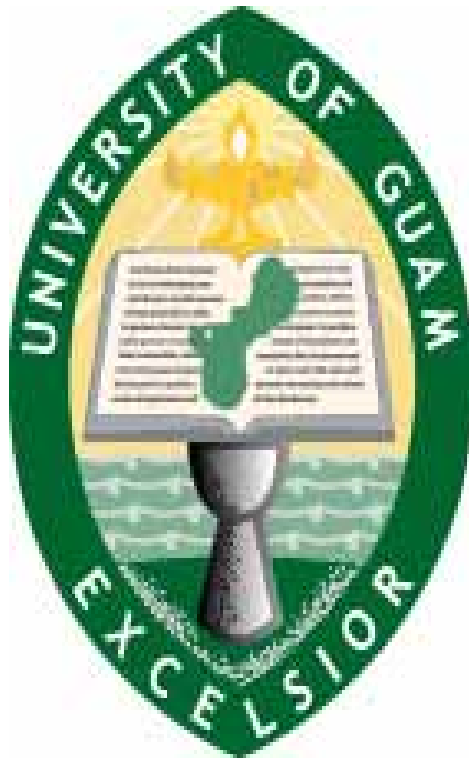

Pacific Postsecondary Institution Transfer Student Persistence at UOG
