

## UNIVERSITY OF GUAM UNIBETSEDAT GUAHAN BOARD OF REGENTS

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 10-02**

RELATIVE TO APPROVING THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE STUDENT AFFAIRS, SCHOLARSHIP, ALUMNI RELATIONS AND HONORARY DEGREE COMMITTEE DURING ITS MEETING OF FEBRUARY 11, 2010 ON THE STUDENT FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FY2011 BUDGET INCLUDING THE YAMASHITA TEACHER CORPS, WHICH PROVIDES BENEFITS FOR AY 2010-2011 FOR NEW APPLICANTS, AND CONTINUING RECIPIENTS.

**WHEREAS**, the governance and control of the University of Guam is vested in the Board of Regents of the University of Guam; and

**WHEREAS**, the provisions of Title 17 of the Guam Code Annotated, Chapter 15, governing the Student Financial Assistance Fund, state that the Student Financial Assistance Fund shall be administered and granted by the Board of Regents in accordance with Public Law 30-55, Section 5 as amended; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with applicable provisions, the Student Affairs, Scholarship, Alumni Relations and Honorary Degree Committee held a meeting on February 11, 2010 to address the Student Financial Assistance Program FY2011 Budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the budget for the Yamashita Teacher Corps is included under the purview of SFAP, pursuant to Public Law 30-73; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Regents continues to seek funding to support the Board of Regents programs and will ask the Legislature for reallocation authority as well as pursue other avenues of funding; and

WHEREAS, the Senior Vice President, Academic and Student Affairs, the Dean, Enrollment Management and Student Services, and the Acting Director, Financial Aid Office have all certified that the Student Financial Assistance Program FY2011 Budget as recommended at the February 11, 2010 meeting is consistent with appropriate Public Laws and the Board of Regents' Rules and Regulations; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of that meeting, the Student Affairs, Scholarship, Alumni Relations and Honorary Degree Committee recommends to the Board approval of the Student Financial Assistance Program FY2011 Budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the University of Guam Student Financial Assistance Program FY2011 Budget named above and attached hereto is hereby approved for submission to the Legislature.
