## Graduate Admissions Requirements checklist:

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- 2 Have a Bachelor's degree with a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Send an official transcript\* from the college or university you earned your Bachelor's degree from directly to Graduate Studies Admissions. Transcript must indicate conferral of your degree. Hand delivered transcript will be considered unofficial. IMPORTANT: If you earned your Bachelor's degree from UOG, you don't need to submit one.
- 3 Prepare, sign and submit a **Letter of Intent and Statement**, identifying a specific Masters Degree Program and stating of <u>accomplishments</u>, <u>interest</u>, <u>goals</u>, and <u>reasons</u> relating to the Masters Degree Program. Address to the Registrar, Remy B. Cristobal
- 4 Submit Resume or Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- 5 Submit two (2) **Signed Letters of Recommendation** from individuals that are familiar with your academic or professional performance. Address to the Registrar, Remy B. Cristobal Note: Three (3) LORs required for Biology and Environmental Science.
- 6 Provide **proof of residency** for tuition purposes to the <u>Graduate Admissions Office</u>. (Mayor's Verification of Residency, active Military Order, Voter's Registration, Verification of Employment, etc.) See Residency Policy.
- 7 Visit the Student Health Service, 735-2225, by the Bookstore at the Student Center. Provide written documentation of a TB test (PPD) taken within the past six (6) months (and results of an x-ray if PPD is positive), in addition if born in 1957 or later, evidence of vaccination against mumps, measles, and rubella (MMR 1&2).

Note: Students who are strictly on ONLINE COURSE cohort are exempt. uogstudenthealth@triton.uog.edu

- 8 Obtain **Graduate Program Entry Form** form is available at the Graduate Admissions Office Seek initial interview/ advisement and review with the Program Chair/Coordinator and Graduate Committee Members on how to plan and complete the degree requirements of the program and be accepted into the program
  - PMBA Program requires Graduate Management Admission Test (GMAT, <u>www.mba.com</u>) and a business program essay.
