### SENIOR CITIZEN (TUITION WAIVER PROGRAM)

### PAYMENT DEADLINE

#### January 29, 2015 – Payment Deadline for Fall Registration:

Final payment for SPRING 2015 Registration must be received by 4:00pm, January 29, 2015 otherwise, your registration will be cancelled. Even if your schedule is cancelled, you are still liable to pay your financial obligation.

**If you are a financial aid recipient or are interested in financial aid, please contact the Financial Aid Office to ensure that all necessary documents are complete before the payment deadlines.**

*YOU MUST OFFICIALLY WITHDRAW IF YOU DECIDE NOT TO ATTEND. SEE THE FEE SCHEDULE IN THE CANCELLATION POLICY SECTION AND WITHDRAWAL POLICY SECTION FOR DEADLINES.*

1. If you drop/withdraw from class(es) before January 21, 2015, you will receive a 100% refund. No Cancellation Fee
2. If you drop class(es) during the first week of class (January 21 – 27) you are charged a cancellation fee equivalent to 5% of the tuition plus 100% of all fees.
3. If you withdraw from class(es) after January 27, 2015 to May 15, 2015, you are charged a cancellation fee equivalent to 100% of the tuition and fees.
4. Students who are waiting for financial aid or have not yet paid for their tuition and fees are still obligated by the above regulations 1 and 2.
5. If you do not officially drop or withdraw from class(es) within the time periods above and still owe tuition and fees, you are liable for payment and will be billed accordingly including applicable interest, and you may receive an Unofficial Withdrawal (UW) grade which negatively affects your GPA. Therefore, it is crucial that you officially drop or withdraw from class(es) in a timely manner.

### BEFORE YOU REGISTER

#### 1. SEEK ACADEMIC ADVISEMENT PRIOR TO REGISTRATION OF CLASSES.

It is important for students to seek academic advisement prior to the registration of classes. Students are urged to contact the appropriate advisor as soon as the class schedule is available to discuss course prerequisites, the requirements of their academic programs, and the courses offered in the current class schedule.

5. **MAKE SURE ALL OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS ARE ON FILE AT THE ADMISSIONS & RECORDS OFFICE**
6. **DECLARE YOUR MAJOR AT THE RECORDS OFFICE IF YOU ARE UNDECLARED AND HAVE COMPLETED 60 CREDIT HOURS**

**FOR TRANSITION STUDENTS ONLY** – Must register at the Division of English and Applied Linguistic, 2nd floor main office. Transition students must (1) see an Advisor at the Division of English and Applied Linguistic for schedule approval and (2) can only register for courses on the "Transition Student Course List."

### WHEN YOU REGISTER

**EARLY REGISTRATION** - By Class Level. Continuing and returning students may register for classes at the Admissions & Records Office, or any Satellite location, or WebAdvisor (<http://setbisiu.uog.edu/>). An extended period for Early Registration is scheduled for **Dec. 09 – Dec. 31** for continuing students, but may only be done using WEBADVISOR. Schedule adjustments may be made during your scheduled registration dates, open registration, and the schedule adjustment period. **YOU MUST OFFICIALLY WITHDRAW IF YOU DECIDE NOT TO ATTEND. PLEASE NOTE THE CANCELLATION FEE, POLICIES AND WITHDRAWAL, AND DEADLINES.**

**Prerequisite in Progress.** If you plan to pre-register for a course that requires prerequisites(s) **AND** you are currently taking the prerequisites(s) on the current semester, you no longer need to request for an override. You will be allowed to pre-register for the course without an override, **HOWEVER**, if you do not pass the prerequisite course(s) with the required grade, your pre-registered course will be deleted ("de-registered") from the class roster and you will be notified by email at your student @etriton.edu.gu account. Deregistration will occur no later than three weeks after the grades for the prerequisite courses have been submitted. You can view your grades online with your WebAdvisor account.

### GENERAL REGISTRATION INFORMATION

The University of Guam FALL 2014 Intersession courses will be offered this year between December 20, 2014 and January 17, 2015. Registration is on a "FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS." The respective colleges will be conducting intersession registration starting Tuesday, December 9, 2014 through Friday, December 19, 2014 beginning at 8:30am and concluding at 5:00pm. Schedule Adjustments can be made on December 22, 2014 and will conclude at 5:00pm. You must pay as you register and registration is on a first-come, first-served basis therefore, you must refer to the business office to make payment on the same day as you are processed by the colleges. Registration is confirmed when payment is made in full.

Students who don't make payment by the 4:00pm on Tuesday, December 23, 2014 will be administratively withdrawn from all courses and will be required to pay a \$50 administrative fee. The University accepts cash,

checks (payable to UOG), and credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, & American Express).

Outstanding obligation(s) must be cleared before registering at the UOG Collections Office. Financial Aid recipients should ensure that their names are on official lists submitted to the satellite registration and the Business Office.

#### REFUND/CANCELLATION POLICY

A 100% refund will be warranted when a course is officially canceled or if the student drops the course PRIOR TO the first class meeting day. A 95% refund will be allowed if the student withdraws from the course BEFORE the second class meeting day. Course and Lab Fees are non-refundable.

The University of Guam reserves the right to cancel or change the classes listed in this course schedule as circumstances necessitate. The University also reserves the right to change regulations affecting the student

body at any time. New regulations are adopted and implemented as the governing authorities determine the need and are applicable both to prospective and matriculated students.

#### VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL

Students who officially withdraw after the deadline to withdraw without transcript record entry will receive a grade of "W" (Withdrawal) for all classes from which they withdrew. Students must withdraw at the Records Office; a technician will assist in making the withdrawal. The deadline for VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL for Fall Intersession 2014 is January 2, 2015. (See cancellation fee schedule).

#### WITHDRAWAL BY PETITION

Students who miss the voluntary withdrawal deadline and desire to withdraw a class(es) may petition for permission to withdraw by completing the Petition for Withdrawal Form which is available at the Admissions & Records Office. Students may petition for withdrawal up until the last day of classes which, for the Fall Intersession 2014 term, is January 16, 2015. (See cancellation fee schedule).

# TUITION & FEE PAYMENT

**Resident and Non-Resident Students** An applicant is initially classified as a resident or non-resident for tuition purposes at the time of application with the Office of Admissions. The classification, which is certified by the Registrar, is based upon information furnished by the student and from other relevant sources. In compliance with the Residency Policy passed by the Board of Regents on February 1996 and amended on May 1997 and June 17, 2004, students in Non-Resident status are required to pay non-resident tuition.

The considerations used in determining Residency status are as follows:

**a.** Establishment of a domicile on Guam or in one of the Freely Associated States (the Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, the Marshal Islands, or the Republic of Palau) as mandated by 17GC16125. (a) for a period of twelve month prior to the beginning of the term for which residency is claimed, or

**b.** Evidence of residency for a period of twelve months or more prior to the beginning of the term for which residency is claimed. Evidence of residency will be shown by a student providing documentation from one of the following<sup>1</sup>:

- Permanent employment on Guam (verification of employment)
- Payment of income taxes of Guam (by student, or by parent/guardian if the student is a dependent).
- Ownership or rental of living quarters on Guam.
- Continue to use a Guam permanent address on ALL RECORDS (educational, employment, military, financial).
- Retain your Guam voter's registration.
- Maintain a Guam driver's license or vehicle registration. If it is necessary to change your license or registration while temporarily residing in another location, the license MUST be changed back to Guam within 10 days of the date of return to Guam, and the vehicle registration must be changed within 20 days of the date of return.
- Village Mayor's certification of residency.

**c.** Adjustment to Permanent Resident Status Students who have filed for an Adjustment to Permanent Resident Status will be eligible for resident rate only if they have resided on Guam for twelve consecutive months prior to applying to the university and have submitted the following supporting documents:

secutive months prior to applying to the university and have submitted the following supporting documents:

- A Notice of Action for the Adjustment to Permanent Resident Status from the USCIS.
- Proof of residency (documents to prove living on Guam for the last twelve months prior to applying to the university).

A Notice of Action denying the student's application for an Adjustment to Permanent Resident Status will render the student ineligible for resident tuition rate.

The burden of proof is upon the student making a claim to resident student's status. The admission of students who knowingly provide false information for the purpose of achieving resident status shall be subject to cancellation and adjusted billing.

### Exemptions to the twelve-month requirement where resident classification may apply<sup>1</sup>:

#### Graduate of a Guam High School

You may be entitled to an exemption from nonresident tuition if you attended high school in Guam for three (3) or more years AND graduated from a Guam high school. You are not eligible for this exemption if you are a nonimmigrant alien.

#### Attended Elementary and Middle School on Guam

You may be entitled to an exemption from nonresident tuition if you attended both elementary AND middle school on Guam. You are not eligible for this exemption if you are a nonimmigrant alien.

#### Active Military Duty

United States Military personnel and their authorized dependents (as defined by the Armed Services) during the period such personnel are stationed in Guam on active duty. NOTE: This exception does not apply to employees of other U.S. federal government departments, bureaus, or agencies or their dependents who are assigned or stationed to Guam.

#### Legal Place of Residency

You may be entitled to an exemption from nonresident tuition if you are able to demonstrate to the Registrar that Guam is your legal place of residency and you intend to make Guam your permanent place of residency.

You may be entitled to an exemption from nonresident tuition if you are able to demonstrate that you permanently reside in Guam, but have been absent for only educational, training, or military reasons.

#### 1Non immigrant aliens, e.g. B,F,H,E Visa holders, are classified as non-residents and are not qualified for resident tuition rates or exemptions.

If you are classified as a non-resident and wish to be considered for resident reclassification, complete the "Petition for Residency Student Classification" before the semester or term you wish to enroll. Approved changes of status will become effective for the term or semester following the approval; they are not retroactive, and no refunds will be given.

**\*\*You must officially withdraw from class(es) by the May 15, 2015, otherwise, you will receive a "UW" (unofficial withdrawal) for the class(es). Students who wish to withdraw from all courses after the "Schedule Adjustment" period must submit a Notification of Course Withdrawal form.**

**Students who are waiting for financial aid or have not yet paid for their tuition and fees are still financially obligated.**

**If you do not officially drop or withdraw from class(es) within the time periods scheduled and still owe tuition and fees; you are liable for payment and interest charges and will be billed accordingly. Therefore, it is crucial that you officially drop or withdraw from class(es) in a timely manner.**

**COURSES CANCELLED BY THE UNIVERSITY** - Full refund will be mailed within four to six weeks.

Tuition, fees, and the refund policy are subject to change as approved by the Board of Regents

**ADMINISTRATIVE DROP** - The Registrar may ADMINISTRATIVELY drop a student from any class for which she/he does not have the PREREQUISITE COURSES, or EXEMPTION from the prerequisites, whether the student enrolls in such a class during the registration or drop/add period. Students who are ADMINISTRATIVELY DROPPED after the REFUND PERIOD are not eligible for a REFUND of tuition or fees.

### WITHDRAWAL POLICY

- **DEADLINE TO WITHDRAW WITHOUT TRANSCRIPT RECORD ENTRY FOR SPRING 2015 is January 27.** All students may withdraw from a course or courses during registration or add/drop period except for TRANSITION STUDENTS who must file a withdrawal form at the Records Office. (See cancellation fee schedule).
- **VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL**  
Students who officially withdraw after the deadline to withdraw without transcript record entry will receive a grade of "W" (Withdrawal) for all classes from which they withdrew. Withdrawal forms must be received by the Admissions and Records Office on or before the deadline; a technician will assist in making the withdrawal. NOTE: Withdrawal forms without all required signatures will NOT be accepted. **The deadline for VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL for SPRING 2015 is March 11, 2015.** (See cancellation fee schedule).
- **WITHDRAWAL BY PETITION**  
Students who miss the voluntary withdrawal deadline and desire to withdraw a class(es)

may petition for permission to withdrawal by completing the Petition for Withdrawal Form which is available at the Admissions & Records Office. Students may petition for withdrawal up until the last day of classes (before finals week) which, for the SPRING 2015 term, is May 15, 2015, (See cancellation fee schedule).

### FINANCIAL AID

### ADMISSION

**DEFINITIONS** (for tuition purposes):

**Resident Student** - Resident of Guam, Federated States of Micronesia (FSM), the Marshall Islands, Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas (CNMI), the Republic of Palau, and the United States who have met the Residency Requirements.

**Non-Resident Student** - Students who have not met the Residency Requirements. (See Residency Requirements)

**UNDERGRADUATE** - First-time students must complete an Application for Admission and must submit required documents by the deadline indicated in the Schedule of Application Deadline section. Official transcripts must be sent directly to the Admissions Office from the issuing institution(s). Applications may be submitted online at <https://www.applyweb.com/apply/guam/> or mailed to the Admissions Office, UOG Station, Mangilao, Guam 96923. Failure to include the application fee will result in the denial of the application. Applications may be dropped at the Admissions Office, located in the Field House, 1st floor. **NON-REFUNDABLE PROCESSING FEE (\$49 Resident & Non-Resident/\$74 International)** must be

paid at the Cashier's Office, located in the Administration Building, before submitting your application. (Cashier's office hours: 8:00 am – 4:00 pm)

**New Freshmen** - All entering Freshmen must take the English and Math Placement Examinations prior to registration. Students who place into EN085 or have not taken the English and Math Placement Tests are classified as "TRANSITION STUDENTS" and will be limited in their enrollment to certain approved courses for transition students.

**Transfer Students** - Students (applicants) are required to take the English and Math Placement examinations and may only be exempted if an official transcript has been submitted indicating the completion with a grade of "C" or better in the following:

- (1) three semester hours of college English for exemption from the English exam, and
- (2) three semester hours in intermediate algebra, college algebra, or finite math for exemption from the math exam.

Students who place into EN085 or have not taken the English and Math Placement Tests and have not fulfilled (1) and (2) are classified as "TRANSITION STUDENTS" and will be limited in their enrollment to certain approved courses for transition students.

**Non-Degree** - Applicants seeking specific courses for personal enrichment or professional advancement who do not seek a degree program may apply as a Non-Degree Undergraduate. A Non-Degree student is not required to submit high school or previous college records or to take placement examinations unless the student is seeking to enroll in English and/or Math courses. (See Undergraduate Catalog - "Non-Degree Student" for more information and requirements).

**GRADUATE** - Applicant seeking admission to a graduate program or to enroll in graduate courses must complete an Application for Admission at the Graduate Studies Office and provide supporting documents by the application deadline indicated in the Schedule of Application Deadlines. Contact the Graduate Studies Office for details on the Graduate English Proficiency Exam (GEPE). Official transcripts must be forwarded directly to the Graduate Studies Office from the issuing institution(s). Applications are available at, and must be submitted to, the Graduate Studies, Research and Sponsored Programs, University of Guam, Health Science Building, 1st floor, room 420. Applications without the appropriate fee will not be processed.

**Former Students (Re-Entry)** - Students who have not attended the University for one or more regular semesters (Fall or Spring) are required to submit an "Application for Re-Entry" at the Records Office or Graduate Studies, Research and Sponsored Programs, University of Guam, Health Science Building, 1st floor, Room 420 at least one week before registration. Official transcripts from all colleges and/or universities attended during the student's non-attendance at UOG are required and must be submitted directly to the Records Office from the issuing institution(s) prior to registration. Proof of residency and standard enrollment requirements may be applied. Forms are available at the Admissions & Records Office or <http://setbisiu.uog.edu/>

Official transcripts from all colleges and/or univer-



sities attended during the student's non-attendance at UOG are required and must be submitted directly to the Records Office from the issuing institution(s) prior to registration. ### GRADUATION

Students who plan to graduate must file an Application for Degree early in the semester before the semester in which he/she plans to graduate. Application fee is \$44.00. There is an additional expense for postage and handling if the diploma is to be mailed off-island. If a student fails to complete degree requirements, after filing the application, he/she must then submit a new application. Reapplication Fee is \$24.00. The deadline to apply for degree completion for 2015 Spring is September 30, 2014.

### IMPORTANT FACTS TO KNOW

1. Students must complete EN111 with a grade of a "C" or better and MA085 (level II) or MA084b or higher with a grade of a "P2" before enrolling in level 300 or 400 courses -- Exceptions are noted in the Undergraduate Catalog.
2. All School of Business and Public Admin majors must complete EN111 and MA 110 or higher with a grade of "C" or better before enrolling in 300 or 400 level courses.
3. A student may not take a lower level course after completing a more advanced level course without written permission from the appropriate department/unit.
4. If your academic program does not specifically require MA161A as a major requirement or a prerequisite course, MA110 may be used

to satisfy your general education math category.

5.
