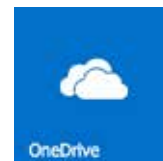
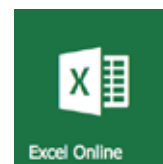
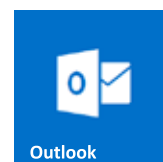

Dear UOG Students,

The University of Guam is committed to your success by providing a quality education in a safe environment. Sexual harassment and misconduct of any kind on-campus, off-campus and anywhere is unacceptable. The safety and well-being of all members of our University Community is not only our priority, but a responsibility we share with our students.

As a University of Guam student and a member of the University Community, you have the right to learn and study in an environment free from sexual misconduct and discrimination. You also have the right to file a complaint and have it heard in a responsible and clear manner.

To ensure your rights are upheld, we have taken the following steps to strengthen our processes and policies:

Sexual Harassment Training

Beginning October 2015, UOG has required all employees to complete annual online sexual harassment training. Beginning Fall 2016, all students will also be required to take the online training before registering for classes.

Sexual Misconduct Policy Update

In Fall 2015, President Underwood created a five-member Task Force which included UOG representation from faculty, staff and students to recommend revisions to our sexual harassment and consensual sex policies. A special Board of Regents meeting will be held in March to adopt the new policy. You can view the policy on the UOG website.

UOG Helpline

We have established a dedicated **Helpline at 735-HELP (4357)** which anyone can call directly to report any sexual misconduct. All reports will be considered privileged information and will be investigated.

A Helpline website has also been launched at www.uog.edu/helpline with easy to understand information and resources about your options, rights and instructions on what to do if you or someone you know has experienced sexual harassment or discrimination.


Facility Upgrades

Final payment for Fall 2016 Registration must be received by 4:00pm, August 25, 2016 otherwise, your registration will be cancelled. Even if your schedule is cancelled, you are still liable to pay your financial obligation.

If you are a financial aid recipient or are interested in financial aid, please contact the Financial Aid Office to ensure that all necessary documents are complete before the payment deadlines.

WITHDRAWAL

YOU MUST OFFICIALLY WITHDRAW IF YOU DECIDE NOT TO ATTEND. SEE THE FEE SCHEDULE IN THE CANCELLATION POLICY SECTION AND WITHDRAWAL POLICY SECTION FOR DEADLINES.

1. If you drop/withdraw from class(es) before August 17, 2016, you will receive a 100% refund. No Cancellation Fee
2. If you drop class(es) during the first week of class (August 17 – 23) you are charged a cancellation fee equivalent to 5% of the tuition plus 100% of all fees.
3. If you withdraw from class(es) after August 23, 2016 to December 09, 2016, you are charged a cancellation fee equivalent to 100% of the tuition and fees.
4. Students who are waiting for financial aid or have not yet paid for their tuition and fees are still obligated by the above regulations 1 and 2.
5. If you do not officially drop or withdraw from class(es) within the time periods above and still owe tuition and fees, you are liable for payment and will be billed accordingly including applicable interest, and you may receive an Unofficial Withdrawal (UW) grade which negatively affects your GPA. Therefore, it is crucial that you officially drop or withdraw from class(es) in a timely manner.

FALL 2016 TRANSITION STUDENTS REGISTRATION

August 1 & 2

Transition Students must register at the Division of English and Applied Linguistic, 2nd floor EC Building main office.

BEFORE YOU REGISTER

- 1. SEEK ACADEMIC ADVISEMENT PRIOR TO REGISTRATION OF CLASSES.**
It is important for students to seek academic advisement prior to the registration of classes. Students are urged to contact the appropriate advisor as soon as the class schedule is available to discuss course prerequisites, the requirements of their academic programs, and the courses offered in the current class schedule.

WHEN YOU REGISTER

EARLY REGISTRATION BY CLASS LEVEL.

An extended period for Early Registration is scheduled for May 07 – July 16 for continuing students, but may only be done using WEBADVISOR. Schedule adjustments may be made during your scheduled registration dates, open registration, and the schedule adjustment period.

NOTICE TO UOG STUDENTS: Prerequisites and @etriton Student Email

Prerequisite in Progress. If you plan to pre-register for a course that requires prerequisites(s) AND you are currently taking the prerequisites(s) on the current semester, you no longer need to request for an override. You will be allowed to pre-register for the course without an override, HOWEVER, if you do not pass the prerequisite course(s) with the required grade, your pre-registered course will be deleted ("de-registered") from the class roster and you will be notified by email at your student @etriton.edu.gu account. Deregistration will occur no later than three weeks after the grades for the prerequisite courses have been submitted. You can view your grades online with your WebAdvisor account.

@etriton.edu.gu. Please be advised that the University of Guam will now only use your student email account (@etriton.edu.gu) to officially correspond when doing so by email. If you do not have your @etriton address and PIN, please visit the Admissions & Records Office. Go to <http://etriton.edu.gu/mail/> for @etriton email, and if you prefer, also update your @etriton profile to forward emails to your personal email address (@yahoo, @hotmail, etc.)

ORIENTATION/REGISTRATION FOR NEW STUDENTS.

All new students must attend academic advising and orientation according to their scheduled date. Admissions Office will send invitations to new students to attend advisement through email based on placement results and academic major advisor availability. Therefore, please make sure we have a valid email address on file. Registration takes place at the Admissions and Records Office in the Calvo's Field House.

OPEN REGISTRATION. All students may register for classes at the Admissions & Records Office (1st floor Field House), or any Satellite Location, or WebAdvisor (<http://setbisiu.uog.edu/>).

SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENT. All students may make schedule adjustments at any Satellite Location or at the Admissions & Records Office.

AFTER REGISTRATION

SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENT.

YOU MAY ADD OR DROP CLASSES DURING EARLY, OPEN, AND DURING THE SCHEDULE ADJUSTMENT PERIOD. A schedule adjustment may be made at any Satellite Location or at the Admissions & Records Office.

AUDITING CLASSES.

Student may apply to audit classes without credit. Please refer to the catalog for application procedures, deadlines, and fees.

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE STUDENT TO REVIEW HIS/HER CLASS SCHEDULE FOR ACCURACY. COURSES NOT ATTENDED AND NOT DROPPED WILL RECEIVE THE GRADE OF "UW" (Unofficial Withdrawal) AND THE STUDENT WILL BE FINANCIALLY OBLIGATED FOR THE PAYMENT OF COURSE(S) AND OTHER FEES.

PAYMENT OF COURSES.

Students must adhere to payment deadlines. Payments are accepted at the Cashier's Office located in the Administration Building. If payment is made by mail, it must reach the University by the payment deadline. Checks should be made payable to the University of Guam and mailed to: Business Office, Attention: Cashier, University of Guam, UOG Station, Mangilao, Guam 96923, or may pay using webadvisor <http://setbisiu.uog.edu>. Questions regarding payment should be directed to the Bursar's Office at (671)735-2945/46/43.

OBTAINING GRADES. Grade reports and class schedules may be viewed on WebAdvisor (<http://setbisiu.uog.edu/>), or requested at the Admissions & Records Office with a photo ID.

TUITION AND FEE PAYMENT

Resident and Non-Resident Students.

An applicant is initially classified as a resident or non-resident for tuition purposes at the time of application with the Office of Admissions. The classification, which is certified by the Registrar, is based upon information furnished by the student and from other relevant sources. In compliance with the Residency Policy passed by the Board of Regents on February 1996 and amended on May 1997 and June 17,2004, students in Non-Resident status are required to pay non-resident tuition.

The considerations used in determining Residency status are as follows:

1. Establishment of a domicile on Guam or in one of the Freely Associated States (the Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas)
2. Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, the Marshal Islands, or the Republic of Palau) as mandated by 17GC16125. (a) for a period of twelve month prior to the beginning of the term for which residency is claimed, or
3. Evidence of residency for a period of twelve months or more prior to the beginning of the term for which residency is claimed. Evidence of residency will be shown by a student providing documentation from one of the following¹:
 - Permanent employment on Guam (verification of employment)
 - Payment of income taxes of Guam (by student, or by parent/guardian if the student is a dependent).
 - Ownership or rental of living quarters on Guam.
 - Continue to use a Guam permanent address on ALL RECORDS (educational, employment, military, financial).
 - Retain your Guam voter's registration.
 - Maintain a Guam driver's license or vehicle registration. If it is necessary to change your license or registration while temporarily residing in another location, the license **MUST** be changed back to Guam within 10 days of the date of return to Guam, and the vehicle registration must be changed within 20 days of the date of return.
 - Village Mayor's certification of residency.
4. Adjustment to Permanent Resident Status
Students who have filed for an Adjustment to Permanent Resident Status will be eligible for resident rate only if they have resided on Guam for twelve consecutive months prior to applying to the university and have submitted the following supporting documents:
 - A Notice of Action for the Adjustment to Permanent Resident Status from the USCIS.
 - Proof of residency (documents to prove living on Guam for the last twelve months prior to applying to the university).

- A Notice of Action denying the student's application for an Adjustment to Permanent Resident Status will render the student ineligible for resident tuition rate.

The burden of proof is upon the student making a claim to resident student's status. The admission of students who knowingly provide false information for the purpose of achieving resident status shall be subject to cancellation and adjusted billing.

EXEMPTIONS TO THE TWELVE-MONTH REQUIREMENT WHERE RESIDENT CLASSIFICATION MAY APPLY¹:

GRADUATE OF A GUAM HIGH SCHOOL

You may be entitled to an exemption from nonresident tuition if you attended high school in Guam for three (3) or more years AND graduated from a Guam high school. You are not eligible for this exemption if you are a nonimmigrant alien.

ATTENDED ELEMENTARY AND MIDDLE SCHOOL ON GUAM

You may be entitled to an exemption from nonresident tuition if you attended both elementary AND middle school on Guam. You are not eligible for this exemption if you are a nonimmigrant alien.

ACTIVE MILITARY DUTY

United States Military personnel and their authorized dependents (as defined by the Armed Services) during the period such personnel are stationed in Guam on active duty. NOTE: This exception does not apply to employees of other U.S. federal government departments, bureaus, or agencies or their dependents who are assigned or stationed to Guam.

LEGAL PLACE OF RESIDENCY

You may be entitled to an exemption from nonresident tuition if you are able to demonstrate to the Registrar that Guam is your legal place of residency and you intend to make Guam your permanent place of residency.

You may be entitled to an exemption from nonresident tuition if you are able to demonstrate that you permanently reside in Guam, but have been absent for only educational, training, or military reasons.

¹ **Non immigrant aliens, e.g. B,F,H,E Visa holders, are classified as non-residents and are not qualified for resident tuition rates or exemptions.**

If you are classified as a non-resident and wish to be considered for resident reclassification, complete the "Petition for Residency Student Classification" before the semester or term you wish to enroll. Approved changes of status will become effective for the term or semester following the approval; they are not retroactive, and no refunds will be given.

The University of Guam accepts VISA, MASTER CARD & AMERICAN EXPRESS credit cards for payment of tuition/fees.

Undergraduate students taking 5 credits or less will be charged 50% or half of the student fee found in the current catalog for the regular fall and spring semesters. Undergraduate student taking 5 credits or less during the summer term inclusive of sessions, A, B, and C, would be assessed a flat fee of \$104.25.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If you register for a class and later decide to drop or withdraw from class(es), you will be charged a cancellation fee as follows.

August 17-23	5%	100%
After August 23, 2016	100%	100%

There is a different schedule for Saturday classes. See the Business Office for details.

** You must officially withdraw from class(es) by December 09, 2016, otherwise, you will receive a "UW" (unofficial withdrawal) for the class(es). Students who wish to withdraw from all courses after the "Schedule Adjustment" period must submit a Notification of Course Withdrawal form.

Students who are waiting for financial aid or have not yet paid for their tuition and fees are still financially obligated.

If you do not officially drop or withdraw from class(es) within the time periods scheduled and still owe tuition and fees; you are liable for payment and interest charges and will be billed accordingly. Therefore, it is crucial that you officially drop or withdraw from class(es) in a timely manner.

To drop classes students may use webadvisor. If webadvisor is not available students may submit request to drop to admitme@triton.uog.edu prior to deadline to drop for the semester.

COURSES CANCELLED BY THE UNIVERSITY

Full refund will be mailed within four to six weeks.

Tuition, fees, and the refund policy are subject to change as approved by the Board of Regents.

ADMINISTRATIVE DROP

The Registrar may ADMINISTRATIVELY drop a student from any class for which she/he does not have the PREREQUISITE COURSES, or EXEMPTION from the prerequisites, whether the student enrolls in such a class during the registration or drop/add period. Students who are ADMINISTRATIVELY DROPPED after the REFUND PERIOD are not eligible for a REFUND of tuition or fees.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

DEADLINE TO WITHDRAW WITHOUT TRANSCRIPT RECORD ENTRY FOR FALL 2016 IS AUGUST 23. All students may withdraw from a course or courses during registration or add/drop period except for TRANSITION STUDENTS

who must file a withdrawal form at the Records Office. (See cancellation fee schedule).

VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL

Students who officially withdraw after the deadline to withdraw without transcript record entry will receive a grade of "W" (Withdrawal) for all classes from which they withdrew. Withdrawal forms must be received by the Admissions and Records Office on or before the deadline; a technician will assist in making the withdrawal. NOTE: Withdrawal forms without all required signatures will NOT be accepted. The deadline for VOLUNTARY WITHDRAWAL for FALL 2016 is October 05, 2016.

WITHDRAWAL BY PETITION

Students who miss the voluntary withdrawal deadline and desire to withdraw a class(es) may petition for permission to withdraw by completing the Petition for Withdrawal Form which is available at the Admissions & Records Office. Students may petition for withdrawal up until the last day of classes (before finals week) which, for the FALL 2016 term, is Dec. 09, 2016, (See cancellation fee schedule).

FINANCIAL AID

All students are encouraged to fill out a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Applications are available in the Financial Aid Office or on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Government of Guam Student Financial Aid Program applications are available at the Financial Aid Office. Completed applications and required documents are due no later than 5:00p.m. on April 30, 2016. Applications must be postmark on or before April 30, 2016. For more information, please call or visit the Financial Aid Office located at the Fieldhouse.

Note: All Financial Aid Title IV recipients must fill-out an Information Sheet. The Information Sheet is available at the Financial Aid Office located at the UOG Field House or www.uog.edu.

Students who are not able to make full tuition payments by posted payment deadline should stop by the Financial Aid Office.

ADMISSION

DEFINITIONS (for tuition purposes):

Resident Student - Resident of Guam, Federated States of Micronesia (FSM), the Marshall Islands, Commonwealth of the Northern Marianas (CNMI), the Republic of Palau, and the United States who have met the Residency Requirements.

Non-Resident Student - Students who have not met the Residency Requirements. (See Residency Requirements)

UNDERGRADUATE - First-time students must complete an Application for Admission and must submit required documents by the deadline indicated in the Schedule of Application Deadline section. Official transcripts must be sent directly to the Admissions Office from the issuing institution(s). Applications may be submitted online at <https://www.applyweb.com/apply/guam/> or mailed to the Admissions Office, UOG Station, Mangilao, Guam 96923. Failure to include the application fee will result in the denial of the application. Applications may be dropped at the Admissions Office, located in the Field House, 1st floor. NON-REFUNDABLE PROCESSING FEE (\$49 Resident & Non-Resident/\$74 International) must be paid at the Cashier's Office, located in the Administration Building, before submitting your application. (Cashier's office hours: 8:00 am – 4:00 pm)

New Freshmen - All entering Freshmen must take the English and Math Placement Examinations prior to registration. Students who place into EN085 or have not taken the English and Math Placement Tests are classified as "TRANSITION STUDENTS" and will be limited in their enrollment to certain approved courses for transition students.

Transfer Students - Students (applicants) are required to take the English and Math Placement examinations and may only be exempted if an official transcript has been submitted indicating the completion with a grade of "C" or better in the following:

1. Three semester hours of college English for exemption from the English exam, and
2. Three semester hours in intermediate algebra, college algebra, finite math or calculus for exemption from the Math Placement exam.

Students who place into EN085 or have not taken the English and Math Placement Tests and have not fulfilled (1) and (2) are classified as "TRANSITION STUDENTS" and will be limited in their enrollment to certain approved courses for transition students.

Non-Degree - Applicants seeking specific courses for personal enrichment or professional advancement who do not seek a degree program may apply as a Non-Degree Undergraduate. A Non-Degree student is not required to submit

high school or previous college records or to take placement examinations unless the student is seeking to enroll in English and/or Math courses. (See Undergraduate Catalog - "Non-Degree Student" for more information and requirements).

GRADUATE - Applicant seeking admission to a graduate program or to enroll in graduate courses must complete an Application for Admission at the Graduate Studies Office and provide supporting documents by the application deadline indicated in the Schedule of Application Deadlines. Contact the Graduate Studies Office for details on the Graduate English Proficiency Exam (GEPE). Official transcripts must be forwarded directly to the Graduate Studies Office from the issuing institution(s). Applications are available at, and must be submitted to, the Graduate Studies, Research and Sponsored Programs, University of Guam, Health Science Building, 1st floor, room 420. Applications without the appropriate fee will not be processed.

Former Students (Re-Entry) - Students who have not attended the University for one or more regular semesters (Fall or Spring) are required to submit an "Application for Re-Entry" at the Records Office or Graduate Studies, Research and Sponsored Programs, University of Guam, Health Science Building, 1st floor, Room 420 at least one week before registration. Official transcripts from all colleges and/or universities attended during the student's non-attendance at UOG are required and must be submitted directly to the Records Office from the issuing institution(s) prior to registration. Proof of residency and standard enrollment requirements may be applied.

GRADUATION

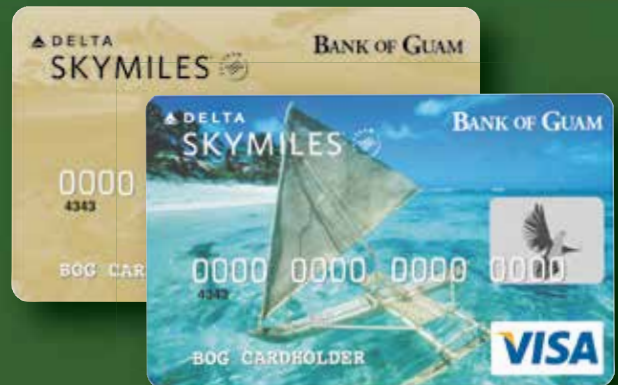
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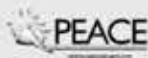

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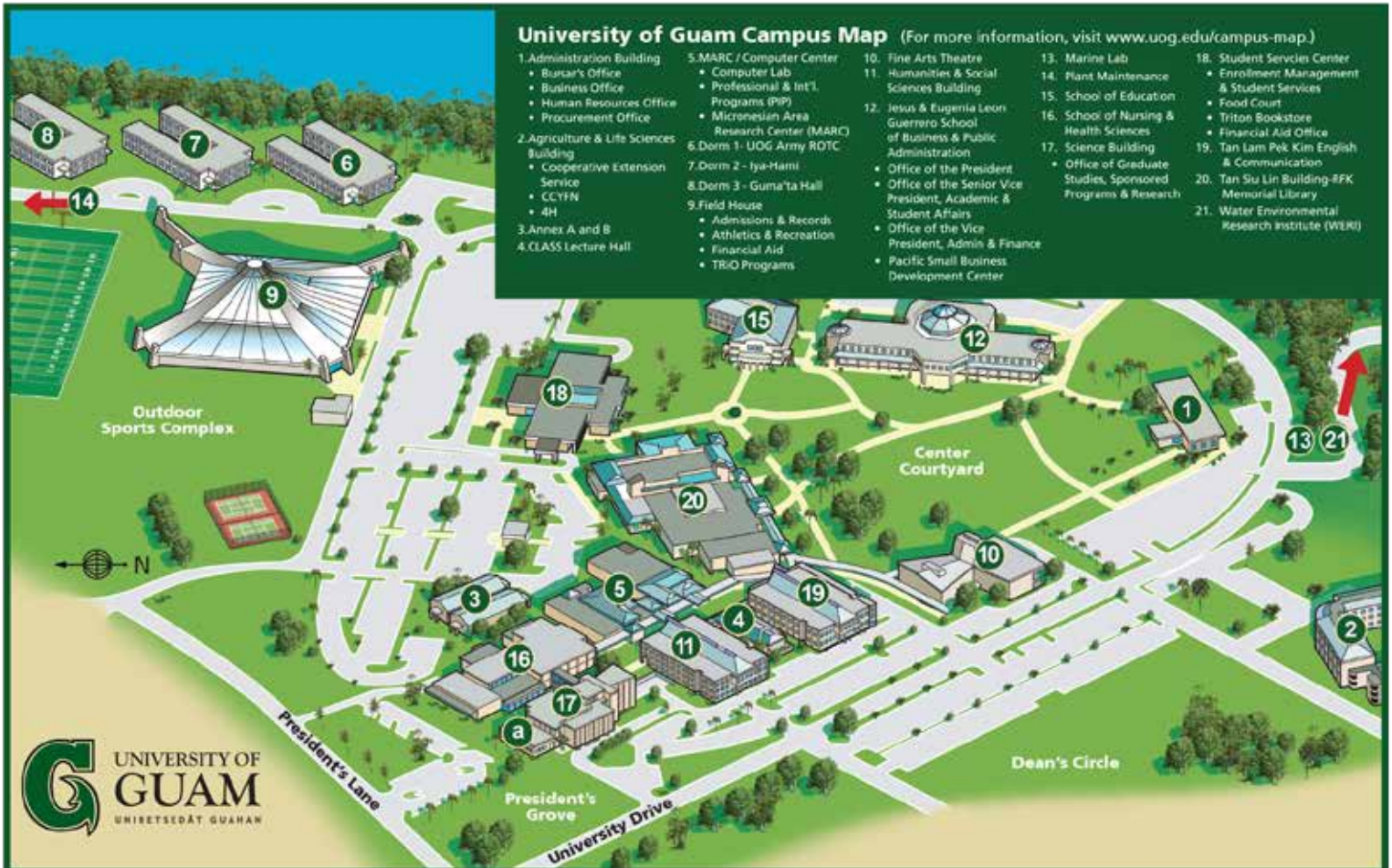
