ABOUT COMMENCEMENT

Academic Dress and Procession

The history of academic dress dates to the Middle Ages when many scholars were also clerics and wore costume of the monastic orders. In 1321, the University of Cambridge adopted specific styles and color combinations. American colleges and universities desired to adopt a standard code for academic dress for colleges and universities in the United States. The standards continue to be followed by the American Council of Education.

The costumes worn today are all traditional and their colors, trimmings and patterns interpret the degree, the field of learning, and the institution that conferred the degree. The bachelor's gown has long pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed; the master's gown has an oblong sleeves open at the wrist. The rear part of its oblong shape is square cut and the front part has an arc cut away. The doctor's gown has bell-shaped sleeves, is faced with velvet and has three bars across the sleeves. The color of the velvet is distinctive of the degree.

The hood tells the story. The type of degree bachelor's, master's, doctor's, is indicated by the width of the velvet edging and the length of the hood, the doctor's hood being the longest and of a fuller shape. The color of the velvet edging denotes the field of learning and the lining denotes the school that conferred the degree.

The color of the tassel, worn on the left side of the mortarboard, indicates the field of study and is gold for those with a doctor's

degree. The colors you will see today in the hoods and gown of our faculty represent the various fields of learning: white, arts, letters, and humanities; drab, business administration; light blue, education; apricot, nursing; dark blue, philosophy; and golden yellow, science.



The academic procession is led by the grand marshal, who is the President of the Faculty Senate. A traditional order to procession is followed: First come the candidates for degrees according to the order in which the degrees are to be conferred; next, members of the faculty led by the faculty marshal, the honorary degree recipient and the other members of the platform party followed by the president of the university. The order is reversed for the recessional.

You will note that some of today's graduates are wearing a gold stole. This stole indicates that the wearer is graduating with academic honors.

The Mace

Historically, the mace was a heavy, spiked club used during the Middle Ages to break armor in battle. Today, the mace is an ornamental staff borne as a symbol of authority before a public official or legislative body. The mace of the University of Guam is made of ifil wood into which are carved ifil leaves. Ifil wood was chosen because of its performance, strength and value, all of which reflect the major characteristics of the University of Guam. The mace, designed by Forrest G. Rogers, was carved and donated to the University of Guam by the Department of Corrections.

COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS

The Honorable **Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero** Governor of Guam *Maga'hågan Guåhan*

Lourdes Aflague Leon Guerrero is the first woman to be elected governor of Guam and the first Pacific Islander woman to serve as governor of a U.S. territory or state. Prior to her election in 2018, she served as president and chairwoman of the board of the Bank of Guam. During her 12 years with the bank, she expanded its network of branches to every island in Micronesia and led the bank to become a \$2 billion institution.

Leon Guerrero served five terms as a senator of the Guam Legislature, championing legislation that focused on improving health delivery services and quality of healthcare – including the Natasha Protection Act, which bans smoking in restaurants and bars. Her interest in healthcare as a lawmaker is rooted in her career as a nurse. Leon Guerrero worked as a nurse at the Santa Monica Hospital in California and at the Guam Memorial Hospital, where she became the assistant nursing director. Following her time at GMH, she spent four years as director of operations of the Family Health Plan clinic. To this day, the Governor is a registered nurse.

Leon Guerrero is also a founding member and the visionary behind the Guam Women's Chamber of Commerce, serving as its first president in 2014.

"I am truly honored to be this year's commencement speaker," she said. "Education is undoubtedly the best investment you can make into your future. No one can take what you learned away from you. I am excited to see so many people empowered by education, and I look forward to the contributions these new graduates will make to our community."

Leon Guerrero earned a bachelor's degree in nursing from California State University, Los Angeles and a master's degree in public health from the University of California, Los Angeles. She is also a 2009 graduate of the Pacific Coast Banking School at the University of Washington.
