Academic Dress and Procession

The history of academic dress dates to the Middle Ages when many scholars were also clerics and wore costume of the monastic orders. In 1321, the University

Cambridge of adopted specific styles and color combinations. American universities colleges and desired to adopt a standard code for academic dress for colleaes and universities in the United States. The standards continue to be followed by the American Council of Education.

The costumes worn today are all traditional and their colors, trimmings and patterns interpret the degree, the field of learning, and the institution that conferred the degree. The bachelor's gown has long pointed sleeves and is designed to be worn closed; the master's gown has an oblong sleeves open at the wrist. The rear part of

its oblong shape is square cut and the front part has an arc cut away. The doctor's gown has bell-shaped sleeves, is faced with velvet and has three bars across the sleeves. The color of the velvet is distinctive of the degree.

The hood tells the story. The type of degree bachelor's, master's, doctor's, is indicated by the width of the velvet edging and the length of the hood, the doctor's hood being the longest and of a fuller shape. The color of the velvet edging denotes the field of learning and the lining denotes the school that conferred the degree.

The color of the tassel, worn on the left side of the mortarboard, indicates the field of study and is gold for those with a doctor's degree. The colors you will see today in the hoods and gown of our faculty represent the various fields of learning: white, arts, letters, and humanities; drab, business administration; light blue, education; apricot, nursing; dark blue, philosophy;



and golden yellow, science.

The academic procession is led by the grand marshal, who is the President of the Faculty Senate, A traditional order to procession is followed: First come the candidates for degrees according to the order in which the degrees are to be conferred; next, members of the faculty led by the faculty marshal, the honorary degree recipient and the other members of the platform party followed by the president of the university. The order is reversed for the recessional

You will note that some of today's graduates are wearing a gold stole. This stole

indicates that the wearer is graduating with academic honors.

The Mace


Historically, the mace was a heavy, spiked club used during the Middle Ages to break armor in battle. Today, the mace is an ornamental staff borne as a symbol of authority before a public official or legislative body. The mace of the University of Guam is made of ifil wood into which are carved ifil leaves. Ifil wood was chosen because of its performance, strength and value, all of which reflect the major characteristics of the University of Guam. The mace, designed by Forrest G. Rogers, was carved and donated to the University of Guam by the Department of Corrections.

HONORARY DEGREE

Donald Benavente Mendiola Master of Micronesian Traditional Knowledge *Honoris Causa*

Donald Benavente Mendiola is an indigenous expert who has made significant contributions to the community in traditional practices as a *yo'åmte* (traditional healer), master weaver, and *fa'fa'nague* (teacher) of CHamoru language. Since his early childhood, Mendiola was recognized by his elders as having the gift of healing and began his service in herbal remedies, massage, and spiritual healing by the age of 9.

As a counselor and guide with Pineksai Haya, a youth cultural immersion program, he has helped youth build awareness and a better understanding of who they are and to gain more self-confidence.



Mendiola has been teaching the CHamoru language for more than 49 years, including

more than 33 years in the Northern Mariana Islands Public School System. He teaches cultural studies at Hopwood Middle School in Saipan, including traditional healing and weaving, and perpetuates his knowledge further by providing training and workshops for other educators.


In 2009, he wrote and published "Åmot Chamorro, a Historical Snapshot of the CNMI's Medical Herbs and Shrubs" to promote first-hand knowledge about herbal remedies to future generations.

HONORARY DEGREE

Patrick Ubal Tellei, Ed.D. Doctor of Humane Letters *Honoris Causa*

Patrick U. Tellei, president of Palau Community College, is the longest serving chief executive of any higher education institution in the Pacific region. Tellei has come to be known for the educational opportunities he has made possible for the people of Palau and the wider region of Micronesia and the many agreements he has brokered with universities and colleges that consistently enhance academic excellence and island progress.

Beyond research and education, Tellei has served as a delegate and secretary to the 2nd Constitutional Convention for Palau, as a catastrophic relief coordinator for Super Typhoon Bopha Recovery, as a governing board member of the Pacific Islands Ocean Observing System, and as a member of the negotiating team for the Compact of Free Association for Palau. He has

also served as an ambassador for Pacific Island-based institutions in regional, national, and international forums.

Tellei earned his Doctor of Education from the University of San Diego in 2005, with his dissertation focused on workforce development in Palau from pre-contact to 1999.

Throughout his career, he has been a supporter of the practice and transmission of island wisdom and traditional lifeways within educational settings and beyond. As an advocate and adviser to national, regional, and international leaders, Tellei has emphasized the importance of education to addressing the critical challenges of our time.

COMMENCEMENT ADDRESS and HONORARY DEGREE John Ray Taitano, M.D., MSS, FCAP Doctor of Humane Letters Honoris Causa

Dr. John Ray Taitano is the first graduate of the University of Guam to be accepted into medical school and the first state surgeon of the Guam Air and Army National Guard.

After earning his bachelor's in biology from UOG in 1968, Dr. Taitano built a successful military career and has been serving the people of Guam as an internal medicine specialist for 42 years.

He became the first CHamoru to earn a Doctor of Medicine from the University of Hawai'i at Mānoa John A. Burns School of Medicine and later became the first CHamoru physician to graduate from the U.S. Army War College.

Seeing the need for medical professionals in Guam, he returned home to give back to the community that supported him.

With three of his colleagues in 1985, Dr. Taitano co-founded The Doctors' Clinic in Tamuning, one of Guam's longest running private clinics.

Throughout his career, Dr. Taitano has also been active in Guam's medical community at large – having served as president of the Guam Medical Society, the Guam Veterans Advisory Committee, and the Guam Board of Medical Examiners, to name a few.

He currently serves as chairman of the Guam Memorial Hospital's Department of Medicine and as vice president of the Cancer Council of the Pacific Islands.

Taitano retired from the military in 2006 after 26 years of service. He served in the Vietnam War and in Operation Iraqi Freedom as a Medical Corps Officer. He holds numerous military awards, including the National Defense Service Medal, the Humanitarian Service Medal, and the Vietnam Service Medal with two bronze service stars.

Taitano is also a three-time winner of the UOG Distinguished Alumni Awards and also holds the honorary Doctor of Humane Letters from the UOG Board of Regents.

His greatest accomplishment, however, is his marriage to his college sweetheart, Sera Babauta Chargualaf Taitano of Santa Rita, and their four sons – John Ray Taitano II, Dr. Johnathan Ryan Taitano, Jon Robert Taitano, and Jason Raymond Taitano, who have blessed the family with their wonderful spouses and grandchildren.
