



## Continuing Nutrition Education Without Interruption

All projects in the Community Nutrition Education Program (CNEP) were implemented throughout the fiscal year without interruption despite the COVID-19 pandemic by transitioning to online delivery. Direct education reached 188 adults, 342 children, grades K-12, and 482 preschool children using different delivery learning modes. Indirect education continued throughout the year using live and recorded cooking demonstrations with 1,427 participants of all ages. Similarly, the 5-2-1-Almost None community-wide social marketing campaign in schools, food stores, community groups, and municipalities were promoted online, on-site, and during mass communication in eight participating 5-2-1-Almost None villages where village residents learn, shop, plant, and play. These goals could not have been met without community partnerships that Extension & Outreach CNEP sustains and fosters with 22 community groups and strengthened with 17 outreach events. CNEP is well-prepared and adaptable to address emerging issues of healthy living using multiple delivery approaches and maximize community partnerships in compliance with safety protocols and island regulations.
