When the pandemic spread worldwide, Extension responded to shortages of hand sanitizer and the reliability about “home remedies”. The concern was some “recipes” contained unsafe components, risking other health maladies and harm to the user. Utilizing the linkages to other Extension systems, Guam 4-H Youth Development professionals quickly formatted a brochure and a self-directed teaching outline for youth to understand hand sanitizer basics, basic chemistry, and safe use by humans.
