

The Frederick J. Horecky Scholarship

Bio of the Donor

Attorney Fred Horecky is an active member in our island business community. He is the proprietor and managing attorney at his law firm, The Law Offices of Horecky & Associates. Mr. Horecky has been practicing law for over three decades and has received the 2013 US Small Business Administration's Minority Small Business Award for Guam. Mr. Horecky continues to give back to our island community by providing scholarships to our UOG students.

Purpose of the Scholarship

The primary purpose of the fund is to provide an annual scholarship to the University of Guam in the name of the Frederick J. Horecky Scholarship. Each year the university will award one scholarship to a recipient who meets the requirements below. The University will have sole discretion to choose scholarship recipients from all eligible applicants.

Eligible Scholarship Recipients

All scholarship applicants must meet the following qualifications:

- The applicant must be enrolled at the University of Guam as a graduate student of the School of Business and Public Administration.
- The applicant must have a minimum 2.5 grade point average at the University of Guam and once selected, he or she must maintain an overall 2.8 grade point average throughout the scholarship period.
- The applicant must maintain good academic standing at the University of Guam.
- Award is based on financial need.
- Minority students encouraged to apply.

The amount of the scholarship awarded each year shall be \$500.

Number of Scholarships

The university may award one (1) scholarship each year.

Duration of Scholarship

The scholarship will be awarded annually. Applicants for the scholarship must reapply each year.
