 - o Cooperative Fire Protection Program
- Support implementation of highest priority plantings in urban, rural and undeveloped areas that meet multiple objectives.
- Support efforts to protect, conserve and restore forests on public, private, and other non-military lands.
- Support efforts to improve fire prevention and mitigation activities through assisting with organizing volunteer events and efforts, assisting in training activities, and assisting in pre/post wildfire monitoring and or surveys.
- Support implementation of forest health program and unifying interagency efforts to control invasive species.
