Scholarship Name: AAUW-Guam Branch

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Applicant must be a student currently enrolled and pursuing an associate degree at the Guam Community College (GCC) or successfully completed at least two (2) semesters at the University of Guam (UOG).
2. Applicant must have at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA).
3. Applicant must provide a current official transcript for proof of current GPA.
4. Applicant must submit a completed AAUW Scholarship Application Form.
5. Applicant must submit two (2) letters of recommendation from two (2) GCC or UOG faculty/staff.
6. Applicant must submit a 500-word essay (typewritten, double-space) on one of the following topics:
 - a. Barriers women in Guam encounter in reaching top employment positions
 - b. Employment of women in STEM fields
 - c. Response to an AAUW issue (<http://www.aauw.org/issues/>)
 - d. Cultural influences on women's careers

Amount and Number of Awards: Two (2) \$550 scholarships for academic year 2019

Application Deadline: Completed application must be submitted to the UOG Financial Aid Office **Friday, February 25, 2019 at 5pm**. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.

Selection Process: The AAUW Scholarship Committee will rate the applications based on applicant GPA, letters of recommendation, and essay.

Selected scholarship recipients must show proof of registration for Spring 2019 semester prior to dissemination of the scholarship. Scholarship recipients are expected to attend the AAUW scholarship dinner and award presentation in March. Scholarship recipients are expected to join the AAUW-Guam Branch as a student affiliate, reactive the student AAUW chapter and actively participate in AAUW events throughout the year.
