  - Engaging presentation format that involves the audience and stimulates discussion.
  - Information about equipment needs (i.e. BYOD format – Bring Your Own Device) and special accommodations.
- Proposals are due April 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 via online submission on <http://guampec2020.org/presenter/>
- Presentations will be reviewed for relevance and purpose, based on presentation strands.
- Presenters will be notified about their proposal status via email by May 1, 2020 to confirm participation.
- Presenters must make payment of \$150.00 (early registration rate by May 15, 2020) or \$250.00 (regular registration rate after May 15, 2020).
