Question 1: What version of HP-UX are they running? (32 or 64 bit?) **Answer:** UOG states: HP-UX coll1 B.11.31 U ia64 (uname-a).

Question 2: What are you currently using for backup?

Answer: UOG states: Tape via Unix TAR command.

Question 3: Do they have any recovery point objectives?

Answer: UOG states: Yes, UOG has daily backups for data and one full system backup weekly.

Question 4: Do they currently back this data up and if so, are they having problems with their

current backup solutions?

Answer: UOG states: Yes, data is currently being backed up daily. However, we've never tested or

restored a backup.

Question 5: What is the current backup solution and methodology?

Answer: UOG states: Currently, we run the TAR command to back up to tape. Refer to the above

responses regarding our recovery point objectives.

Question 6: Also, what's the version of RHEL are they going to? Is SE Linux required?

Answer: UOG states: UOG would like to be on the most recent Ellucian-supported version of RHEL.
