REQUIREMENTS FOR SENATOR

From the current SGA Constitution:

ARTICLE II

ELECTED OFFICIALS

SECTION 2: QUALIFICATION AND TERMS OF OFFICE

- Par. 1: All elected officials shall have completed at least fifteen (15) University of Guam semester credit hours prior to obtaining their respective offices.
- Par. 2: All elected officials shall maintain academic good standing as stated by the Board of Regents prior to obtaining their office and must maintain the minimum GPA while in office. Elected officials falling below the minimum GPA requirements will be automatically removed from office.
- Par. 3: Each elected official of the SGA Council shall serve for one (1) calendar year starting in the month of August.

SECTION 8: DUTIES OF SENATORS:

- Par. 1: The duties and powers of Senators shall be as follows:
1. To faithfully attend all meetings and SGA Council Regular and Special sessions.
 2. To represent the interest of the general members of the SGA to the SGA Council.
 3. To author at least one (1) bill and one (1) resolution per semester, which require action to be taken.
 4. To serve and attend all meetings of at least one (1) University Wide Committee that has no more than one (1) other representative.
 5. To chair and/or co-chair at least one (1) SGA-sponsored activity per year and to assist in carrying out all other SGA-sponsored activities needed.
 6. To execute all duties and responsibilities assigned by the SGA Council.
