AN ACT TO APPROVE MONIES TO SUPPORT THE NORTHERN MARIANAS SOCIETY IN THEIR RELIEF EFFORTS TO SAIPAN DUE TO THE ONSLAUGHT OF TYPHOON SOUDELOR.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE FIFTY-FOURTH STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED

Section 1. Legislative Intent and Purpose. This Act is intended to support the Northern Marianas Society in their relief efforts to Saipan, due to the onslaught of Typhoon Soudelor, for the cost of one thousand three hundred dollars (\$1,300.00). The amount will be used to purchase a total of 20 care packages for 20 families at a cost of about sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) each. Each care package will comprise of consumable items such as water, spam, corned beef, tuna, crackers/biscuits, and raisins. Non-consumable items such as toilet tissue, baby wipes, mosquito coils, candles, and rubbing alcohol will also be included. This relief effort aims to assist families in Saipan who are in dire need of basic life necessities, as the supply of food and water is distributed in limited rations.

Section 2. Approval. Upon passing of this Act, the 54th Student Government Association approves the sum one-thousand three hundred dollars (\$1,300.00) only and shall not exceed this said amount. Said amount shall come out of the SGA Student Activities or Operations account.

Section 3. Surplus. Should excess in funds of the total amount approved by this act exist thereafter purchases, said amount shall be labeled "unexpended funds" and shall be returned to the SGA Student Activities or Operations account.

Section 4. Enactment. This Act shall be effective immediately upon passage.

AN ACT TO APPROVE MONIES TO SPONSOR SGA MONTHLY ACTIVITIES FOR THE DURATION OF FALL SEMESTER 2015 (AUGUST-DECEMBER 2015).

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE FIFTY-FOURTH STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED

Section 1. Legislative Intent and Purpose. This act is intended to provide funding for monthly SGA-sponsored activities as an individual organization or through collaboration and partnerships with interested student organizations willing to host an event or activity on behalf of SGA for any month from August through December 2015.

Section 2. Approval. Upon passing of this act, the 54th Student Government Association approves the sum of two thousand dollars only (\$2,000.00). Said amount shall come out of the SGA Activities or Operations account to be used to purchase any materials needed or secure services relative to sponsoring a monthly activity as approved by the SGA Council. Each monthly event shall not exceed five hundred dollars (\$500.00), though multiple events may be sponsored so long as the designated budget for the month is not exceeded.

Section 3. Surplus. Should excess in funds of the total amount approved by this act exist thereafter purchases, said amount shall be labeled “unexpended funds” and shall be returned to the SGA Activities or Operations account.


Section 4. Enactment. This Act shall be effective immediately upon passage.

AN ACT TO APPROVE THE CREATION OF A POINT SYSTEM FOR THE CHARTERED STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS AND TO AWARD THE WINNING STUDENT ORGANIZATIONS FOR ATTENDING THE MOST SGA SESSIONS AND SGA-SPONSORED EVENTS DURING THE FALL 2015 SEMESTER.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE FIFTY-FOURTH STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED

Section 1. Legislative Intent and Purpose. It is the intent of this Act to create a point system for the chartered Student Organizations (SO) of the University of Guam to encourage SOs to attend SGA sessions and SGA sponsored events and be involved with university activities. The intent of this Act is to also have the different SOs collaborating with each other in goodwill.

Winning SOs will be awarded based on most points. Point systems will be based on how many sessions and events each SO attended. Qualification for receiving points is for each SO to have a minimum of one (1) representative attend each SGA regular session or special session and a minimum of one (1) representative and a maximum of (5) representatives attending an SGA-sponsored event.

During regular or special sessions, each SO will be awarded two (2) points per session, and during SGA-sponsored events, each SO will be awarded one (1) point for every member that attends. An SO can only receive the points if they have the minimum requirement of members attend the sessions and the events. An SO also can only receive a maximum of two (2) points per regular session or special session and five (5) points per event. A student body member can only represent one (1) student organization. It is the duty of the student body member to sign in with the SGA representative to receive the point(s).

Section 2. Approval. Upon passing of this Act, the 54th Student Government Association approves the sum of two thousand one hundred dollars (\$2,100.00) and shall not exceed this said amount. Said amount shall come out of SGA Student Activities or Operations account and deposited into the top ten (10) SOs' accounts. A grand prize of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) will be awarded and deposited into the account of the SO with the highest points and two hundred dollars (\$200.00) will be awarded and deposited into the account of the remaining nine (9) SOs.

In the event that more than ten (10) SOs qualify for winning the prize money, the grand prize will be cancelled out and the prize of two thousand one hundred dollars (\$2,100.00) will be divided evenly among the winning SOs and deposited into the winning SOs' accounts.

Section 3. Surplus. Should excess in funds of the total amount approved by this act exist thereafter purchases, said amount shall be labeled "unexpended funds" and shall be returned to the SGA Student Activities or Operations account.

Section 4. Enactment. This Act shall be effective immediately upon passage.

Said amount shall come out of SGA Operations account for the purchases of, but not limited to, items such as office supplies, and any other supplies and materials necessary for the daily use of the SGA office and SGA-sponsored activities.

Section 3. Surplus. Should excess in funds of the total amount approved by this act exist thereafter purchases, said amount shall be labeled "unexpended funds" and shall be returned to the SGA Operations account.

Section 4. Enactment. This Act shall be effective immediately upon passage.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING THE 54th STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION STIPENDS.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE FIFTY-FOURTH STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED

Section 1. Legislative Intent and Purpose. This act is intended to establish the stipend amount for the 54th Student Government Association council members. Additionally this Act requires that each council member be accounted for during SGA sessions and be present during working hours (maximum of two (2) hours per weekday) for a minimum of five (5) hours a week.

Section 2. Approval. Upon passing of this Act, the 54th Student Government Association shall approve the amount no less and no more than fifty dollars (\$50) per regular session from the SGA Operations account and twenty-five dollars (\$25) per special sessions to be used to support the aforementioned council members from the twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00) based on what was allocated by the Board of Regents. The amount to be given to the council members will be determined by the SGA President upon receiving a timesheet or log in sheet that documents the council member's presence at the hall.

Section 3. Surplus. Should excess in funds of the total amount approved by this act exist thereafter purchases, said amount shall be labeled "unexpended funds" and shall be returned to the SGA Operations account.

Section 4. Enactment. This Act shall be effective immediately upon passage.

This act is intended to approve monies for a monthly stipend for the services obtained from the appointed Office Manager for maintaining documents, equipment, and the SGA Hall. The Office Manager duties are, but not limited to: ensuring the cleanliness of the hall, enforcing office policies, accountability of office keys, materials, and documents, receives and channels all concerns from the Student Body in the absence of the SGA council, work orders, and be the Chairperson of the Student Committee, and other duties that the council sees appropriate. The appointed Office Manager must attend all SGA Sessions and must complete a minimum of five (5) hours a week. A stipend shall be given to the appointed Office Manager in relieving aforementioned duties: therefore, giving the 54th SGA Council members ample time in executing their duties as described in the Student Government Constitution and By Laws.

Section 2, Approval. Upon passing of this Act, the 54th Student Government Association approves the sum of twenty five dollars (\$25.00) each session, with maximum of two (2) sessions a month, at a maximum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per month. Office hours: twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50) per week, four (4) times a month, the minimum of five (5) hours per week, and maximum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per month, as mentioned in Bill 54-05. The funding shall come out of the SGA Operations account.

Section 3, Surplus. Should excess in funds of the total amount approved by this act exist thereafter purchases, said amount shall be labeled “unexpended funds” and shall be returned to the Student Operations account.

Section 4, Enactment. This Act shall be effective immediately upon passage.



The purpose of funding student publications will help inculcate in students important reading habits that will continue after graduation. Its forum of editorials, letters and columns encourages the resolving issues by reasoned debate. It also provides an outlet for student writing that primarily emphasizes services rather than self-expression.

The publication(s) will be made available to all, including the University community and the island public. It shall convey an image of the University to the community. It shall help silence rumors that often arise in the absence of information. It can provide feedback on school rules and regulations that affect students while maintaining order by reporting violations of the student handbook. The student press and publications help keep the student governance in check, which is essential for the democratic process. Most importantly, it facilitates the educational process through reporting on academic subjects and courses.

Publications can include, but are not limited to, Triton’s Call, KUOG, and other student organizations newsletters that aid students and stimulate participation and/or attendance.

Section 2, Approval. Upon passing of this Act, the 54th Student Government Association approves the sum of ten thousand dollars only (\$10,000.00) and shall not exceed this said amount. Said amount shall come out of SGA Student Operations account for the purchase of, but not limited to supplies, printing, stipends, and production necessary for executing the activities.

Section 3, Surplus. Should excess in funds of the total amount approved by this act exist thereafter purchases, said amount shall be labeled “unexpended funds” and shall be returned to the SGA Operations account.

Section 4, Enactment. This Act shall be effective immediately upon passage.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE FIFTY-FOURTH STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED

Section 1. Legislative Intent and Purpose. This act is intended to support the delegation of student leaders from the 54th Student Government Association to attend the National Conference on Student Leadership Fall 2015. The NCSL Fall 2015 will be held in Washington, D.C. from November 19 – 22, 2015. Participation in the NCSL Fall 2015 will help the 54th SGA promote the University of Guam to other universities from around the country. Participation in the Conference will also be beneficial for UOG in a number of ways:

- Upon completion, those that take part in the conference will become certified student leaders;
- It will help in the 54th SGA's efforts in establishing a mentoring program with the Student Counseling Services from the Enrollment Management and Student Success to improve the first-year experience, which will hopefully increase the retention rate by providing the program with a number of certified leaders and mentors;
- The knowledge gained from the variety of workshops available will enhance our fall and spring assemblies, which are constitutional requirements, by adding breakout sessions based on the workshops from the conference; and finally,
- It will help provide the 54th SGA with the opportunity to host more events centered around training the general student assembly to become more effective student leaders and mentors and effectively serve the UOG community as a whole.

The 54th Student Government Association will offset part of the cost of travel through fundraising efforts in sending delegates to the conference. BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE FIFTY-FOURTH STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED


