RELATIVE TO RECOGNIZING MR. KYLE SANDBERGEN AS STUDENT GOVERNEMENT ASSOCIATION OFFICE MANAGER AND STUDENT COMMITTEE CHAIRPERSON

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE FIFTY-FOURTH STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED

WHEREAS, as stated in the student government by laws Article XIII: SGA Complementary Office, Section 03: Office is to facilitate and introduce collateral titles, duties and responsibilities of elected SGA Officials to satisfy overall mission; and

WHEREAS, the office manager duties are, but not limited to: ensuring cleanliness of the hall, enforcing office policies, accountability of office keys, materials, and documents, receives and channels all concerns from the Student Body in the absence of the SGA Council, work orders and e the Chairperson of the Student Committee, and other duties that the council sees appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the 54th Student Government Association approves the sum of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) each session, with a maximum of two (2) sessions a month, at a maximum of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per month. Office Hours: twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50) per week, four (4) times a month, the minimum of five (5) hours per week, and maximum of fifty (\$50.00) per month, as mentioned in Bill 54-05. The funding shall come out of SGA’s Operations Account; therefore be it

RESOLVED, that Article XIII: SGA Complementary Offices, Section 03: Offices, reads:

- Par. 1: There may exist, an SGA Office Manager who is granted the following powers and be responsible for the following duties and responsibilities;
1. Posting and adhering to a schedule of office hours to ensure the availability of the SGA Office Manager to conduct administrative and operational requirements;
 - a. Shall ensure the cleanliness of the SGA Office and other facilities under control of the SGA Council,
 - b. Recommends and enforces all SGA policies and approved,
 - c. Schedules for the use of the SGA Office and/or other facilities under control of the SGA Council, at the direction of the SGA President;
 - d. Distributes and maintains accountability of all keys accessing facilities under control of the SGA Council (with the exception if the SGA Office), at the direction of the SGA President.
 2. Receives and channels all concerns addressed to the SGA Council in the absence of appropriate officials.
 3. Maintains accountability of all office materials [i.e. papers, staples, computer mediums], and related items for convenient access for administrative uses.
 4. Recommends ad hoc task forces composed of both SGA officials and SGA general members to assist the SGA Office Manager with fulfilling those responsibilities listed in these By-laws. Any such task force(s) shall be directed by the authorities, duties, and responsibilities as composed by the SGA Office Manager and approved by a simple majority vote of the SGA Council.



RELATIVE TO ESTABLISHING THE PROCEDURES, POLICIES, AND PURPOSES REGARDING INVESTMENT FUNDS.

BE IT HEREBY ENACTED BY THE FIFTY-FOURTH STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN COUNCIL ASSEMBLED

WHEREAS, the 54th Student Government Association affirms an investment account located at First Hawaiian Bank under account number 35-072985; and

WHEREAS, the 54th Student Government Association wishes to close the account number 35-072985 in lieu of a new investment account under the current 54th Student Government Association leadership; and

WHEREAS, the initial amount under the new account will be sixty-three thousand two-hundred four dollars and thirty-eight cents (\$63,204.38) only of which the corpus is fifty thousands dollars (\$50,000.00) only; and

WHEREAS, the investment policy regarding the aforementioned investment funds include the preservation of the corpus originally endowed by the Thirty-Ninth Student Government Association of the University of Guam of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the investment policy regarding the aforementioned investment funds include the original corpus amount that would be remaining after the governing Student Government Association during the maturity date of the time certificate deposit be re-invested into a time certificate of deposit no less than eighteen (18) months at the First Hawaiian Bank; and

WHEREAS, the accrued interest from the investment funds should be the only amount used for Student Government Association of the University of Guam purposes; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned purposes include, but are not limited to, student leadership development; and

WHEREAS, the Fifty-Fourth Student Government Association of the University of Guam designates the signatories for the access to the investment funds at the First Hawaiian Bank to be either the governing Student Government Association President, Vice President, or Treasurer in office during the use of the funds and the Associate Dean of Enrollment Management and Student Success; and

WHEREAS, if the Associate Dean of Enrollment Management and Student Success is unavailable, the comptroller of the University of Guam can act on his or her behalf. Therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the Fifty-Fourth Student Government Association of the University of Guam acknowledge and recognize the investment funds located at the First Hawaiian Bank; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the 54th Student Government Association acknowledge and recognize the investment funds' aforementioned investment, spending, and First Hawaiian Bank account access policies; and be it further
