AM I ELIGIBLE?

Eligibility Criteria:

- Demonstrate an Academic Need. And meet any of the following:
- First generation college student (neither parent nor legal guardian received a baccalaureate degree).
- Low-income based on federal guidelines.
- Student with disability (physical and/or learning.)

HOW TO APPLY

- Complete and submit application with supporting documents.
- Applications are reviewed to determine eligibility.

Eligible applicants will be contacted for interview and services will follow as needed.
